Rusty called the meeting to order and Tiffany presented the Regular meeting minutes from April 16, 2025. Rusty motioned to approve the minutes and Mike seconded. Motioned carried.

Tiffany presented the 6/30/25 financial statement. Rusty motioned to approve the financials as presented. Mike seconded, and motion carried. - Tanker – Kevin has been working with Ben Brown, Legacy Alexis Fire. Kevin requested images.

### Clinton Township Operations Report

- Supply Hose – This will be removed from old business for the October meeting.
- Hose Tester – works great per Paul.
- Rescue 11 (Brush Truck) – Back on Station. JTN lights and wiring not expected to exceed \$2,000.
- Repairs – hose reel, fuel mechanism, minor pump repairs ETA prior to 9/30/25
- Hovercraft – Awaiting title. Funds returned should go to the Department, and not the District. Tony Camp has applied for a replacement title.

### New Business

- Open Door Policy – State Office of Technology offers a website that can be used by the District.

- Turnout Gear – Clinton gaining new members. Contact Mike if emergency gear is needed. Otherwise the Board advised to wait until the next board meeting to request an order.
